TITLE: Intramural and Club Sports Coordinator – (Full-Time, Contingent) 10-Month

JOB SUMMARY:

The Intramural and Club Sports Coordinator is responsible for developing, coordinating, and administering the intramural and club sports programs. This role includes planning, organizing, and promoting a wide range of sports activities to enhance the student experience, foster community engagement, and promote physical well-being. The coordinator will work closely with students, staff, and other stakeholders to ensure a safe, inclusive, and enjoyable environment for all participants. This position reports to the Director of Athletics & Recreation.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Responsible for following the policies and procedures as defined in the employee handbook.
- Designs and implements a diverse array of intramural and club sports programs.
- Schedules and oversees regular intramural leagues, tournaments, and special events.
- Coordinates with club sports teams to support their activities, including practice schedules, competition arrangements, and travel logistics.
- Promotes intramural and club sports programs to the campus community through various marketing and communication strategies.
- Fosters a welcoming and inclusive environment for all participants, regardless of skill level.
- Ensures all intramural and club sports activities adhere to safety guidelines and best practices.
- Oversees the use and maintenance of sports facilities and equipment.
- Coordinates facility reservations and ensures spaces are prepared for activities.
- Manages inventory and procurement of sports equipment and supplies.
- Coordinates, implements, and evaluates a comprehensive Sport Club Officer Training curriculum for the 15 Sport Clubs. Develops and facilitates officer training to ensure sport club compliance with SMCM Athletics and Recreation guidelines pertaining to day-to-day operations, risk management, hazing, and off-campus travel.

- Coordinates student development opportunities for sport club officers through yearly programs to target leadership and personal growth.
- Recruits, trains, evaluates, and schedules intramural student staff members.
- Assists in the training of student managers.
- Develops and implements club sports student leaders' program.
- Serves on campus committees as required.
- Provides an annual report of activities.
- Adheres to and follows all rules and guidelines of the College, and the appropriate club and intramural organizations.
- Serves as a Campus Security Authority in accordance with the Clery Act.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Education: Bachelor's degree required; Master's degree preferred from an accredited institution.
- Experience: One or more years of referee, campus recreation, or other sports management experience.
- Experience in Whentowork Software, Fusion Software, IMLeagues Software or similar software.
- Current CPR/First Aid/AED Certification or eligible to be certified.
- Ability to administer multiple ongoing tasks and follow complex administrative procedures.
- Ability to travel occasionally.
- Ability to work weekends and nights.
- Must possess a valid driver's license.
- Ability to lift approximately thirty (30) pounds.
- Any combination of acceptable education and experience, which has provided the necessary knowledge and skills to fulfill the requirements of this position, may be considered.
